

Housing Legal Assistance



The Center for Housing Opportunities has partnered with Neighborhood Legal Services to assist individuals in the following areas:

- **Tangled-Title:** Legal assistance up to \$5,000 - If you own a home, but need the deed transferred to your name
- **Eviction Prevention:** Legal assistance up to \$3,000 - If you are at risk of eviction, or are currently experiencing eviction and need legal assistance

To qualify, you must meet the following requirements:

Eviction Prevention Assistance

- Client must live in the City of Pittsburgh
- Client's income must be at or below 50% AMI*
- Clients who are wrongfully threatened with lock-out, facing eviction, or are living in sub-standard conditions may be eligible

Tangled-Title Assistance

- Client must live in the City of Pittsburgh
- Client's income must be at or below 80% AMI*
- Client must not have any outstanding City, School, and County real estate taxes, or must be on a payment plan for at least 3 months

** For income requirements, please refer to the chart on the back.*

Program Income Limits

For **eviction prevention** assistance, income must not exceed 50% AMI

For **tangled-title assistance**, income must not exceed 80% AMI
