

Housing Stabilization Program



If you have been affected by COVID-19 and need rental or utility assistance, contact United Way 211 for more information on the Housing Stabilization Program. A limited amount of funding is also available for homeowners to assist with mortgage payments.

The Housing Stabilization Program (HSP) is a housing crisis intervention program that provides one-time or short term (up to 3 months) financial assistance to households who are facing a temporary, non-reoccurring housing crisis.

One-time funding support includes:

- 1) Move-in assistance which may include:
 - First month's rent
 - Last month's rent
 - Security deposit
 - Utility deposits
- 2) Utilities in arrears
- 3) Rent in arrears
- 4) Mortgage payment (must not have an Act 91 notice)
- 5) Legal fees

Short-term funding support includes:

- 1) Rent subsidy, not to exceed three (3) months
- 2) Legal services throughout the eviction process
- 3) Legal fees related to court

Eligibility Requirements:

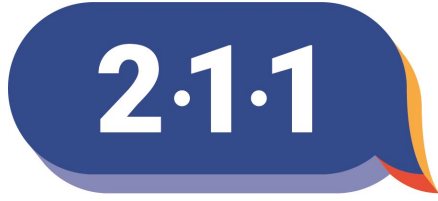
- Must be a renter or homeowner
- Must live in the City of Pittsburgh
- Renters must be at or below 50% AMI*
- Homeowners must be at or below 80% AMI*
- Must develop a stability plan with a service provider
