Housing Legal Assistance



The Center for Housing Opportunities has partnered with Neighborhood Legal Services to assist individuals in the following areas:

- Tangled-Title: Legal assistance up to \$5,000 If you own a home, but need the deed transferred to your name
- Eviction Prevention: Legal assistance up to \$3,000 If you are at risk of eviction, or are currently experiencing eviction and need legal assistance

To qualify, you must meet the following requirements:

Eviction Prevention Assistance

- Client must live in the City of Pittsburgh
- Client's income must be at or below 50% AMI*
- Clients who are wrongfully threatened with lock-out, facing eviction, or are living in substandard conditions may be eligible

Tangled-Title Assistance

- Client must live in the City of Pittsburgh
- Client's income must be at or below 80% AMI*
- Client must not have any outstanding City,
 School, and County real estate taxes, or must be on a payment plan for at least 3 months

For eviction prevention assistance, income must not exceed 50% AMI

For tangled-title assistance, income must not exceed 80% AMI
