



# **OwnPGH Homeownership Program**

The OwnPGH Homeownership Program (OwnPGH) provides up to \$90,000 to first-time homebuyers seeking to purchase a home within the City of Pittsburgh.



## About the Program

Homebuyers may receive up to \$90,000 total, in the form of a grant and a loan, to aid in the purchase of a house within the City of Pittsburgh.

- A \$50,000 grant may be available for those with a household income of 80% of Area Median Income (AMI) or below.
- A \$40,000 loan may be available for those with a household income of 80% AMI or below. This is a 0% interest, forgivable loan, that can be forgiven after 10 years.

## Who Can Apply?

- Participation in OwnPGH is subject to bank approval. Individuals must first pre-qualify for a home loan through one of three URA bank partners; Please view the back of this flyer to find contact info for the participating banks.
- Individuals who do not exceed 80% of AMI;
   Please view the chart on the right to check if your household income is within the program income limits.
- Individuals who would like to own a property within the City of Pittsburgh; Properties outside of City of Pittsburgh limits do not qualify for OwnPGH assistance.

### **Area Median Income Limits**

This chart shows the maximum annual income limits for those interested in applying for the OwnPGH Program.

Annual Gross Income = Total income received by the entire household, before taxes and withholdings

## **Additional Homebuying Assistance**

First-time homebuyers making less than 80% of the AMI may be eligible to **receive up to \$7,500** for **down payment and closing costs** in the form of a 0% interest, 5-year deferred loan.
