

Demonstration Dollars FAQ

- **Can the funds be used for pre-development work?**
 - Funds can be used for pre-development for the innovative project, but cannot be used for pre-development for any existing HOF program. This grant is competitive and the closer a project is to implementation, it will be a more competitive application.
- **Does the URA anticipate the projects to be the full scope or a smaller portion of a project?**
 - The project does not need to fund the full scope provided the smaller portion of the project is the innovative aspect of the project.
- **If a project is both a service and a development, which one should the applicant choose?**
 - There is not a preference. Applicants should be thoughtful about their narrative and select whether they are a service or a development based on what better aligns with their narrative and supporting data.
- **Are there any prevailing wage requirements?**
 - If construction is involved, state prevailing wage must be followed.
- **Do MWBE and MWI standards apply?**
 - Yes. Any project over \$250,000 requires an MWBE plan and any project over \$500,000 requires an MWI plan.
