

# Legal Assistance Program For Homeowners

The **Legal Assistance Program (LAP)** connects people in need of housing legal assistance with the URA’s partner providers. **Homeowners** in households earning 80% of the area median income or below may qualify for free legal services, up to \$5,000.

## Legal Services for Homeowners

- Foreclosure prevention and consultation
- Clearing tangled titles
- Estate planning and consultation

## Who Qualifies?

Homeowners who reside at their property in the City of Pittsburgh and who live in households earning 80% of the area median income or less.

# Legal Assistance Program For Renters

The **Legal Assistance Program (LAP)** connects people in need of housing legal assistance with the URA's partner providers. **Tenants** in households earning **80%\*** of the area median income or below may qualify for free legal services.

## Legal Services for Tenants

- Landlord-tenant mediation
- Limited legal consultation
- Full legal representation for eviction or landlord disputes

## Who Qualifies?

Renters who reside in the City of Pittsburgh and who live in households earning 50% of the area median income or less.

\*There is limited funding available for renters earning between 51%-80% of the area median income. Funding is not guaranteed.
